2002 Unissued design self-adhesive Machin "1" (1st Class) in Red and Machin "2" (2nd Class) in Blue, printed in Booklets of 12 stamps. These Trials were produced in booklet form by Royal Mail in an attempt to aid the physically and visually disabled. In the end Royal Mail decided not to go ahead with the design. Only a handful of complete booklets are recorded. We have a few single stamps which we can offer, normally £650 the pair, ONLY~~£450.00~~ £420.00

2004 Christmas Trials – printed from the same sheet that had the wrong values. It is thought that the Christmas trials of the six denominations were intended to be used in a booklet, but the format was scrapped in favour of 2nd Class Booklets of 24 and 1st Class Booklets of 12. Subtle shade differences exist between the issued stamp and the trials. This is most noticeable on the 1st Class stamp which has less yellow than the issued stamp, and the 2nd Class stamp which has a darker blue background, the pair (1st & 2nd)~~£25.00~~ Now £15.00
